<u>Salford Community Libraries</u> and <u>The Reading Agency</u> present the <u>Silly Squad, Summer Reading Challenge 2020</u>.

Children can enjoying reading books all through the summer, and they can record their progress, unlock digital games and activities, and download a Silly Squad certificate when they finish the challenge.

To sign your child up for the challenge, read the Getting Started information on the <u>information for families</u> page of the website, and then sign up at <u>sillysquad.org.uk</u>.

How to find books to read for the Challenge

- * Read paper books that you have at home, or are able to swap or borrow. You can read them yourself, or ask somebody to read them to you..
- * Use the <u>Salford Community Libraries BorrowBox</u> app to borrow eBooks and eAudiobooks to read or listen to. Children who are not already library members can ask parents/carers to help them <u>join the library online</u>.



- * Watch a video of an author reading one of their books online. For example:
 - <u>Jarvis reads Follow me, Flo!</u>
 - Swapna Haddow reads Little Rabbit's Big Surprise
- * Read books that are available for free online, for instance:
 - J.K. Rowling's new book The Ickaboq
 - You Wouldn't Want to Be An Egyptian Mummy! (and other titles in the You Wouldn't Want to Be series)
